2025 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Thank you for applying for the Nacogdoches County Republican Women's (NCRW) scholarship. We appreciate you taking the time to apply for this scholarship and look forward to reading your essay. The NCRW awards one \$1,000 scholarship. Scholarship money is paid in the winner's name to the school of his or her choice for the upcoming fall semester.

Application Requirements

Applicant must

- be a US citizen and attend a Texas school for at least 2 years
- be attending a Nacogdoches County high school or home school
- be a graduating senior
- be accepted into a 2- or 4-year academic/technical institution of higher learning

Include the following:

- application form and high school transcript
- letter of introduction addressed to the judges
- a copy of your acceptance letter to an institution of higher learning
- evidence of participation in conservative extra-curricular and/or community service activities
- essay of 300 words, not to exceed 2 pages
- ***ANY AI CONTENT IS AN AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFICATION. IT WILL BE TESTED.***
- DO NOT send letters of recommendation

Each year the NCRW Scholarship Committee chooses a new topic. The 2025 essay topic is

“List and discuss Five (5) Threats to American National Security”

Essay Requirements

Essay must be the applicant's original thoughts and words and should reflect the level of composition and standard use of the English language generally expected of entering college freshman. Use paragraphs, correct spelling and punctuation, and concise sentences with a subject and predicate that agree.

Essay format requirements:

- Times New Romans 12 pt. font and double-spaced with 1-inch margins
- not to exceed two 8.5” x 11” pages
- at least 300 words, not counting the title (include word count at the end of your essay)
- Title your essay
- quotes and/or references though not required must be cited using MLA format
- do not include *your* name on the essay itself

It is strongly advised that another person review your work for corrections as noted above. Computer spell and grammar check does not catch all errors! All applicants receive fair and equal review. All decisions are final.

See the Application Form for the mailing and email addresses. Remember the Scholarship will be paid direct to the institute of higher learning of your choice.

The scholarship winner is announced at his or her high school senior awards assembly or graduation ceremony; and when possible, an NCRW member is in attendance and presents the scholarship certificate. The recipient and his or her parents are invited to attend an NCRW luncheon meeting; lunch for recipient and parents are complementary of NCRW. Our members want to meet and congratulate you! During the luncheon, we would like for you to read your essay to the group.
